

Practicing with Multiplication Cards

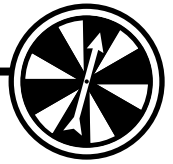
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You need

- 6 sheets of Multiplication Cards
- Array Cards
- scissors
- paper clip
- resealable plastic bag

Play with a partner.

- 1** Cut out each Multiplication Card and write your initials and the product on the back. Check each product with a calculator, your Array Cards, or someone else's help.
- 2** Ask someone to show you the front of each Multiplication Card. Say the product as quickly as you can. If you get it right away, put the card in a pile of combinations that you "just know." If you have to stop and figure it out, put it into a different pile of combinations that you are "working on."
- 3** Paper clip your "just know" cards together and put them in the plastic bag.



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- 4** Look at each card in your “working on” pile. Think of an easy multiplication combination that you already know that can help you remember this one. Write it on the line that says “Start with _____.”

- 5** Practice each of the cards in your “working on” pile at least three times.
- 6** Put all your cards back together (including the ones you “just know”) and go through them again. Keep practicing over the next few weeks until you have no more cards in your “working on” pile.
