Play with a partner.

- 1 Each player shuffles a deck of Collection Cards and places it facedown on the table.
- 2 To begin the game, each player turns over the first two cards in his or her pile.
- 3 Determine who has the larger sum. That player takes all four cards. When the larger sum is obvious and both players agree, the player can take the cards without adding. Otherwise, add each pair or use estimation to figure out who has the larger sum.
- 4 Three times during the game, stop and record. Write the numbers from both players' cards on the *Collections Compare* Recording Sheet. Then answer the questions on the sheet.
- 5 If players do not agree on the sums of each pair, try a different way of adding each pair of cards.
- 6 The game ends when the players have turned over all of the cards in the deck. The player with the most cards is the winner.
