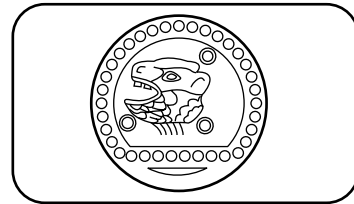


## Chinese Coin Collection
